

Inspection of the Detention Block of the City Centre Police Station of the Northern Prefecture of the Police and Border Guard Board

Early on the morning of 30 August 2014 advisers to the Chancellor of Justice paid an unannounced visit to the detention block of the City Centre Police Station of the Northern Prefecture of the Police and Border Guard Board.

The police building visited by the advisers is a structural unit of the Police and Border Guard Board and its detention block is primarily used to detain people for a short time (intoxicated persons, suspects in criminal and misdemeanour proceedings, persons forced into compelled attendance etc.).

The Chancellor of Justice previously inspected the City Centre detention block on 12 November 2011.

The Chancellor of Justice does not make any additional recommendations or proposals as a result of the inspection visit, but starts proceedings on his own initiative to investigate how minors are taken to police buildings in the area of administration of the Police and Border Guard Board.
