

Inspection of Vönnu Hospital

On 9 April 2014 advisors to the Chancellor of Justice paid an unannounced visit to Vönnu Hospital.

Vönnu Hospital provides nursing care services and care services. The hospital has been issued with an activity permit for providing nursing care to up to 11 patients. The hospital was providing nursing care to six persons at the time of the inspection.

The Chancellor of Justice had not inspected the hospital before.

As a result of the inspection the Chancellor of Justice makes the following suggestions to Vönnu Hospital to guarantee the fundamental rights and freedoms of persons:

- to guarantee the existence of the required system for calling a nurse for nursing care patients;
- to inform patients thoroughly and, if necessary, repeatedly of the existence of the system for calling a nurse and how to use it;
- to guarantee that the window of the reception room is equipped with a covering that guarantees privacy and that screens or other means that guarantee the privacy of patients are used during hygiene or other intimate procedures.
