

Inspection of the Psychiatry Clinic of Pärnu Hospital

On 29 November 2012 advisers to the Chancellor of Justice paid an unannounced visit to the acute and general departments of the Psychiatry Clinic of Pärnu Hospital.

The advisers to the Chancellor of Justice gave particular attention to the isolation room as well as the practice and documentation of the application of restraining measures. As a result of the inspection the Chancellor of Justice suggests that in order to guarantee the fundamental rights and freedoms of persons, Pärnu Hospital change its register of application of restraining measures so that it also indicates the manner in which the person was restrained.
