

Inspection visit to the Headquarters and Signal Battalion

On 10 September 2015, advisers to the Chancellor of Justice conducted an announced inspection visit to the Headquarters and Signal Battalion. During the inspection visit, the advisers interviewed 23 conscripts staying at the Battalion.

The conscripts alleged that, from time to time, their superiors had taken their mobile telephones from them for safe-keeping. In several instances, the Chancellor of Justice has drawn the Battalions' attention to the fact that taking conscripts' mobile telephones for safe-keeping is not consistent with the applicable law. The Chancellor of Justice advised the Battalion to stop taking conscripts' mobile telephones for safe-keeping and to implement measures to prevent the unlawful storage of telephones from occurring in the future.
